# RULES

## USGA. ROYAL & ANCIENT RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY WITH THE AFOREMENTIONED EXCEPTIONS FROM THE RULES COMMITTEE. EFFECTIVE DATE: 1 NOVEMBER 2005

- Hole 1. (OB) Left over road beyond white stakes  
(OB) right of fairway beyond white stake and the perimeter fence. Back of green.
- Hole 2. (OB) Right of fairway beyond white stakes.
- Hole 3. (OB) Right of fairway, around green and left side of fairway beyond cart path as marked with white stakes.  
Water hazard yellow stakes. Use drop zone area, or drop ball keeping the pond between ball and flag.  
Relief for balls on cart path nearest point from path no closer to green.
- Hole 4. (OB) Right and left of fairway, around the green beyond white stakes.
- Hole 5. (OB) Right and left of fairway around the green beyond white stakes.  
Over road to left of fairway as marked with white stakes.
- Hole 6 (OB) Right of fairway beyond cart path down to the pond fence. Left of fairway beyond white stakes. Green Stake-Environment Hazard-Relief for ball beyond the green stakes and in the pond, Go to the drop zone.  
(OB) Left of fairway to the green, as marked with white stakes.  
(OB) Right of fairway from fence to the green, as mark with white stakes  
Relief if ball on road- to be played between bank and road.  
No closer to the hole. No relief for ball on bank.
- Hole 7. (OB) Right of fairway  
Water Hazard. Pond in front on green. Yellow stakes.  
Ball may be dropped keeping the pond between ball and flag.  
(OB) at the back of green, as marked with white stakes.
- Hole 8. (OB) beyond green or as marked with white stakes.
- Hole 9. Hazard-Red Stakes from right of T.Box beyond cart path, along right of fairway to bottom right of fairway as marked. Ball may be played from hazard or dropped keeping point of entry between ball and flag.  
(OB) On the bottom right of fairway beyond cart path, as marked with white stakes.  
(OB) On the left side of fairway leading to the green and beyond cart path to the back of green as mark with white stakes. Relief off cart path to be played between road and bank at top level, and nearest point from road on lower level.  
No relief for ball on bank.
- Hole 10. OB over fence left of fairway
- Hole 11. OB Beyond green as marked.  
The pond is water hazard yellow stakes  
Use drop zone. Ball to be dropped keeping pond between ball and flag

- Hole 12. OB Left of fairway and beyond green as marked with white stakes.
- Hole 13. OB left of fairway and green as marked with stakes.
- Hole 14. OB left of edge of road and left of fairway.  
Pond is a water hazard with Red stakes.  
Ball may be played from hazard or dropped.  
Keeping point of entry between ball & flag.
- Hole 15. OB left of fairway beyond cart path. Relief from road  
to be played nearest point from road
- Hole 16. OB left of fairway over perimeter fence or as marked.  
OB back of green beyond perimeter fence.  
OB left of #14 fairway beyond edge of road/fairway.  
Pond is a water hazard. Ball may be played from hazard or dropped keeping point of entry  
between ball & flag
- Hole 17. OB on left side of fairway as marked.
- Hole 18. OB on left side of fairway as marked.

The Practice Range is out of bounds as marked.

Relief for balls on cart paths no closer to the greens.

No relief for ball on bank on any hole.

Ball may be marked, lifted, cleaned and placed within one foot as long as the ball  
is on the fairway of the hole being played.

NO practice chipping and putting is allowed on all 18 greens.  
The putting green have been designated as practice green.

No relief from recently cleaned areas around the fairway perimeter.

Ball may be drop from all trees below 5 feet tall without penalty.

Ball may be dropped off cart paths and roads at the closest point of relief no nearer  
to the hole without penalty.

Free drop from yardage markers

Stones in bunkers are deemed movable obstructions

# REGULATIONS

1. Golfers must be properly dressed on the course and in club house.
2. Only one golfer is permitted to use one set of clubs.
3. No more than two (2) persons are permitted to ride a golf cart.
4. No more than four persons are permitted to play in a group.
5. Allow fast players to play through.
6. The use of foul language in the club house will not be tolerated. Also please avoid the use of such language on the course.
7. All beverages and food must be purchased on the premises.
8. Observe all signs and roped areas
9. Ride carts in rough and cart paths. Do not take carts within 30ft of greens.
10. All players must register in pro-shop

## LOCAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MEMBERS AND GUESTS. REGULATIONS

1. All players must register in the pro-shop and must first paid Green fees and or cart rental fees; before going out to play on the course.
2. All players must be appropriately dressed on the course and in the club house. The following attire will not be tolerated. Swimsuits, Swim trunks. Tank tops, shorts other than golfers, shirts without collars. All shirts must be worn in pants / shorts.
3. Footwear: Only approved golf shoes will be allowed on the course.
4. Only one golfer will permitted to use one set of clubs. Each player must have his or her own sets of golf clubs and golf bag.
5. No more than two (2) persons are permitted to ride on a golf cart.
6. Players are not allow to carry more than two bags on a golf cart.
7. No more than four persons are permitted to play in a group.
8. All food and beverages must be purchased on the club premises.
